This Introduction to Safeguarding Children, Young Children and Vulnerable Adults course is a positive first step towards increasing and improving your knowledge and will provide you with a thorough overview of how to recognise the warning signs of abuse, what to do with any concerns that you may have and how to feel confident in protecting children, Young Children and Vulnerable Adults from harm.

Safeguarding is a responsibility of all professions and so this training course is suitable for anybody required to take training as part of their role. It is a requirement for all those working with children, young children and adults and/or their families to have knowledge of how to safeguard and by taking this training course you will fulfil that obligation.

This course is written at an introductory level and so no previous knowledge is required. The course is also suitable for workers of all levels, including managers, supervisors, full-time staff, part-time staff and volunteers.

Duration
